The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Derry Township was held on Tuesday, March 12, 2024 at 6:30pm in the Municipal Building. Present were Barbara Wingate, Cathy Martz, John Martz, Greg Molter, Matt Madden, Shawn Betz, Bruce Miller, Kelly Miller, Laurinda Voelcker and Vicki Koser.

The minutes were reviewed and approved by motion of John and seconded by Shawn. The call vote was 3 yes.

Barb Wingate asked when road repairs will be done. The Board will be conducting a survey of the needed road repairs. Cathy Martz stated that the ditches on Fairview Road will need to be cleared. Water is accumulating near the trailer court.

Matt Madden was present to see the progress on our Privy ordinance that is needed for the Hillside Road school project.

Solicitor presented to the Board for approval the completed Privy Ordinance that was duly advertised. The ordinance will be titled 3-12. After reviewing the ordinance 3-12, it was adopted by motion of John and seconded by Shawn. The call vote was 3 yes.

Secretary provided the Board with a PennDOT workshop scheduled for 4/23/2024 from 9:00am to 11:00am at the Danville State Hospital grounds. The 2023 annual general fund audit will take place on Wednesday, March 20, 2024 at 6:00pm in the Municipal Building.

John reported that Bradco was here and they brought us a transit that came as a part of a previous rental agreement. John is working on getting an estimate from them for the mower repair and a price on a spinner style spreader for the T-tag.

Shawn asked about the red light repair and could Tra electric come and check its operation in the dark. That is when it seems to take much longer to change signal. Shawn also asked about Valley Township working with us on Raup Road. Greg reports that we will be getting an estimate from them.

Greg reports that Stephenson Equipment will be at the convention and we can ask them about training on the tar buggy then. Greg also reports that he received a compliment about our crew and the good job that was done removing down trees and limbs.
