Mike Martz questioned who the current Sewage Enforcement Officer is for Derry Township. He stated there are two properties that have malfunctioning systems and nothing has been done about it. The properties are on Bush Road. Greg asked for the property owners names and locations so he could consult with the SEO about enforcement.

The Supervisors agreed to give approval for the Milton Rotary Club annual Harvest Festival Bike race to pass through on Township roads on September 7, 2024.

The Supervisors agreed to go out for bid for the roads listed on the project estimate sheet that was provide by Penndot. The estimated cost is \$194,082.80. Secretary will advertise the bid package for letting on July 9, 2024.
