

AUGUST 13, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Derry Township was held on August 13, 2024 at 6:30pm in the Municipal Building. Present were Jason Braim, Paul St Clair, Laurinda Voelcker, Matt Lisowski, John Martz, Greg Molter, Bruce Miller, Kelly Miller, Dave Diehl, Shawn Betz and Vicki Koser.

The minutes were reviewed and approved by motion of Shawn and seconded by John. The call vote was 3 yes.

Matt Lisowski from Stephenson Equipment and Jason Braim from Medico Industries were present to take questions on their respective proposals for a new mower purchase for the Township.

Paul St Clair lodged a complaint about the ditching and berming that was done on Hillside Road by his home. He stated that the water runoff has ruined his flower beds. Supervisors responded that they would take a look at it to see what the concern is but the job was done by a contracted company – not us.

Dave Diehl reported on his attendance at the NMRPC conditional use variance hearing for a solar project. Dave also has concerns about the amount of horse manure on the roads and what can be done about it.

The Treasurer report was approved by motion of John and seconded by Shawn. The call vote was 3 yes. The bills were accepted for payment by motion of Shawn and seconded by John. The call vote was 3 yes.

John Martz reported that the new cameras have been installed by Tra Electric. The T-Tag has a broken windshield. Supervisors agree to have Safelite come and replace it. John also states the backhoe is acting up again.

More discussion followed on the new mower purchase. Stephenson Equipment offered a Massey-Ferguson boom mower and included a trade in price for the old one. Medico Industries was a Case wheel mower also including a trade in price. Supervisors will review the specs and prices and will make a decision at a later date.

With no further business the motion to adjourn was made by Shawn and seconded by John.
