

September 17, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Derry Township was held on Tuesday, September 17 2024 at 6:30pm in the Municipal Building. Present were Greg Molter, John Martz Sr., Joanne Betz, Kelly Miller, Bruce Miller and Vicki Koser. Supervisor Shawn Betz was absent.

The minutes were approved by Motion of Greg and seconded by John. The call vote was 2 yes.

The Board agreed to the send a 100.00 dollar donation to the Danville Area Halloween Parade by motion of John and seconded by Greg. The call vote was 2 yes.

A date was discussed and set for the annual budget meeting. Secretary will advertise the budget meeting to be held on Oct 8th at 6:00pm before our regularly scheduled monthly meeting.

The Treasurer report was approved by motion of John and seconded by Greg. The call vote was 2 yes. The bills were approved for payment with the exception of the one from New Enterprise Stone and Lime that will be held until the project is completed. Greg made the motion and John seconded. Call vote 2 yes.

John Martz presented an estimate on the repairs that would be needed for the L8000. The estimate for repair was \$2300.00 dollars. John would prefer to sell the truck as is without doing the repairs. Greg is in favor of doing the repairs to get a higher price on a sale. Item was tabled until Shawn is available to give his input. John also reported that the repairs to the backhoe would run about \$20,000.00 dollars.

The purchase of new equipment was discussed next. The quotes that were considered were from Medico Equipment for a Case wheel Loader with a Boom Mower. We would trade john Deere tractor for the trade in value of \$25,000.00 dollars. The other new purchase would be a Case Excavator with the CAT backhoe as a trade in for the value of \$40,000.00 dollars. We would also be purchasing a new trailer from North Point Trailer Sales for the estimate of \$7900.00 dollars. The motion was made by Greg to go ahead with these equipment purchases and trade ins. John seconded. The call vote was 2 yes.

Greg reported that he will be attending a PSATS standing committee meeting on November 19th in Gettysburg,

Joanne Betz stated that she had made some PSATS recommendations concerning Tax Collector duties.

With no further business the motion to adjourn was made by John.
